Shogo Tsukada was born in Japan and has been studying here in the class of Prof. Connie Shih and Prof. Donald Sulzen as Master degree, Chamber music and Lied Interpretation and PGL degree under Prof. Ya-fei Chuang.



Eimi Wakui is a winner of several international violin competitions and won prizes, such as the 3rd prize in the Tibor Varga International Violin Competition Sion Valais, prize winner and special prize in the International Violin Competition – Toruń 2016, 1st prize in the Euro Asia International Competition, 2nd prize in the Oleh Krysa International Violin Competition, finalist in the International Isang Yun competition, 3rd prize in the Yankelevitch International Violin Competition, 2nd prize in the Antonio Vivaldi International Music Competition Vienna, 2nd prize in the International Vaclav Huml Violin Competition.



Since October 2022, **Norman Spaeth** is studying at the Mozarteum University in Salzburg with Hagai Shaham. He reached the finals of the international Arthur Grumiaux Competition. He has won several first prizes at the national competition "Jugend musiziert". In June 2019 he won two first federal prizes in the categories "Violin Solo" and "Piano Chamber Music". He received a first Federal Prize in the "Violin Solo" category and made his debut with the orchestra of the Philharmonie Bad Reichenhall under the direction of chief musical director Christian Simonis with the 3rd Violin Concerto by W.A. Mozart, where upon another invitation from the same orchestra for the season in 2018 followed.



Since October 2022, **Yuya Mizuno** has been studying with Prof. Clemens Hagen at Mozarteum University. He completed the soloist diploma course at Toho Gakuen School of Music on a scholarship under Sumiko Kurata and studied with Miklós Perényi at Liszt Ferenc Academy of Music in Hungary. He has received numerous awards in competitions, including the First prize in the Enrico Mainardi competition, the 13th Tokyo Music Competition and the 89th Music Competition of Japan. His debut album, Kodály Sonata for Solo Cello & Chopin Cello Sonata with Kyohei Sorita was released in 2023.
